Cumulatively, Indonesia's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) during the first quarter of 2017 grew by 5.03% from the target of 5.2%. Meanwhile, in 2018 the Indonesian economy is targeted to grow by 5.4%. Since 1961, Indonesia's economy generally shows a growth trend, only experiencing contraction twice in its history. The peak of this growth occurred in 1968, the beginning of the New Order era, when GDP jumped to 10.92%. In the subsequent reform era, the highest growth rate was recorded at 6.35% in 2007. However, Indonesia also faced challenges, especially during the Old Order era in 1963 and in 1998 in the midst of the Asian financial crisis. The last crisis. characterized by widespread unrest across the country, led to a severe economic downturn, with a GDP contraction of -13. 13%. (Febrian Cahyo Pradono Basukianto, 2015).

This illustrates that Indonesia's economic growth is experiencing systematic growth even though it is not balanced with the formation of professional quality human resources. The government in fulfilling economic growth is only based on objectivity in developing economic quality but is not balanced with the formation of professional human resources.
